



Internships and Research Training: Special Funding Opportunities for Institutions and Students

Colgate-Palmolive/SOT Awards for Student Research Training in Alternative Methods

The Education Committee announces special awards to enhance training in research using *in vitro* methods or alternative techniques to reduce, replace, or refine use of animals in toxicological research, thanks to the generosity of the Colgate-Palmolive Company.

Institutions may apply for funds to support undergraduate summer research internships. Institutions will propose a 10-week summer research experience for students involving *in vitro* toxicology or alternative methods to reduce, replace, or refine the use of animals in toxicological research.

Toxicology graduate students may apply for research support. Students will propose a training experience at a laboratory at or away from their home institution, or to attend a workshop, symposium, or continuing education program to develop expertise in *in vitro* toxicology or alternative methods to reduce, replace, or refine the use of animals in toxicological research. This project will support the applicant's thesis or dissertation research.
