

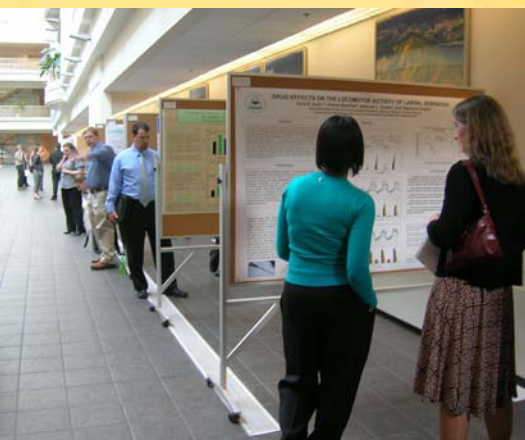


North Carolina Regional Chapter



Membership

Founded in 1981 as one of the first four regional chapters, NC SOT is one of the largest regional chapters, with 374 +members across NC. About 27% are students or postdocs. Mix of industrial/consultant (about half), government (about a third), and academic (about a tenth) toxicologists. Many members work in Research Triangle Park, but members hail from East Carolina University in eastern NC to Winston-Salem in the Piedmont.

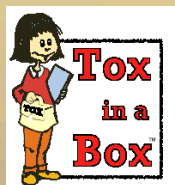
