



2012 Society of Toxicology Pfizer Undergraduate Student Travel Award

Pfizer Undergraduate Student Travel Awards are presented through the Society of Toxicology to outstanding undergraduates who are presenting research at the Annual Meeting. The purpose of this award is to foster an interest in graduate studies in the field of toxicology. Pfizer, Inc. will provide up to 5 awards per year. Awardees will be selected based on the quality of the submitted poster abstract, personal statement, and the advisor's supporting recommendation. The selected undergraduates will receive travel support and free registration for the meeting and a plaque presented at the SOT Awards Ceremony. Recipients will also be recognized at a special event with Pfizer scientists. Awardees will be matched with a Pfizer scientist to mentor them during the meeting and will attend the Society of Toxicology Undergraduate Education Program on Sunday as well as other meeting activities.

Eligibility Criteria

- Abstract submitted by applicant is accepted for the meeting
- Nomination/Letter of reference provided by the research advisor
- Applicant is currently enrolled in an undergraduate program of study at time of the meeting
