



LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE MATERIALS

The undersigned hereby grants to the Society of Toxicology ("SOT") the nonexclusive worldwide right and license to the materials he or she has assembled for the course presentation as identified below, including the rights to publish, electronically store, reproduce, and distribute his or her contribution wholly or in part throughout the world, including translations, in all formats and media of expression now known or later developed, including electronic, as part of this work. While the author licenses the use of his or her portion of the course to SOT and retains copyright to that material, SOT retains copyright for the work in its entirety.

The undersigned also hereby agrees to and warrants the following:

If the materials have been prepared by an employee within the scope of his/her employment, the same rights apply to the employment agency.

U.S. GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES
