- Please email Dr. Sky Reece (wangx@ecu.edu) your platform TITLE, AUTHORS, AFFILIATIONS, and ABSTRACT by Friday, September 29, 2017. The abstract MUST be submitted as a Microsoft Word document, single-spaced using 12 point Times New Roman font, 1 inch margins (please no pdfs). Please write "Student Platform Competition" in the subject line of your email. Please follow SOT abstract guidelines (https://www.toxicology.org/main/abstractGuidelines.asp). Abstracts selected for platform presentations will demonstrate outstanding clarity in methodology/approach, uniqueness/creativity, thoroughness of investigation, soundness of judgment in interpreting results, and relevance.
- You will receive notification of your abstract's status no later than October 9, 2017.
- If NOT selected, you will automatically be entered into the Poster Competition unless you do not wish to present a poster at the annual meeting.

Deadline for abstract submission is Friday, September 29, 2017.
