Individuals

Participation is available only to bona fide organizations with public policy positions and business practices that are generally consistent with the SOT mission, goals, and reputation, as well as its policies and principles, as determined by the Society.

SOT reserves the right to review applications for participation at the SOT Annual Meeting and ToxExpo to confirm that the applicant meets these criteria. The Society may reject a registration by any individual or organization or withdraw registration privileges at any time if the individual or organization is found to be inconsistent with the Society's principles and interests.

Attendance Terms and Conditions

By registering for the SOT 60th Annual Meeting and ToxExpo, you are agreeing to abide by [SOT Code of Conduct policy](#) and to the following terms and conditions, granting SOT permission to:

- Reproduce, copy, and publish your image, voice, and any or all media taken at the Annual Meeting and ToxExpo.

SOT Annual Meeting registrants (excluding registered guests) are:
