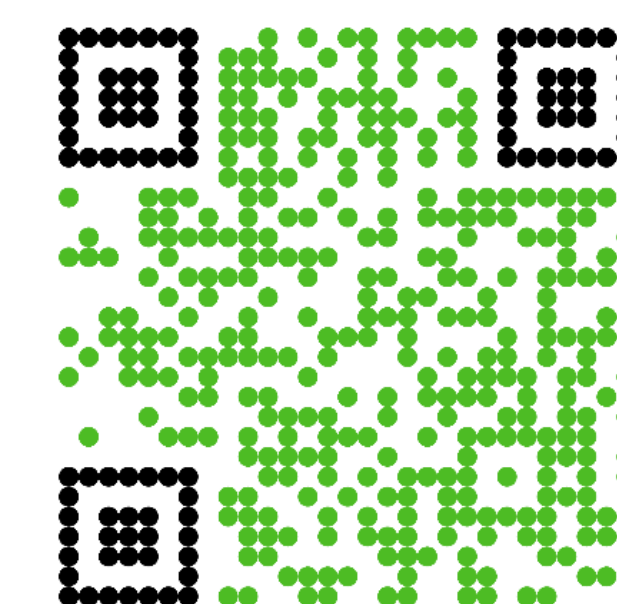


# Immunotoxicology Specialty Section (ITSS)

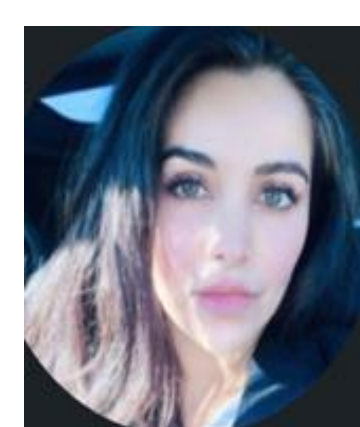

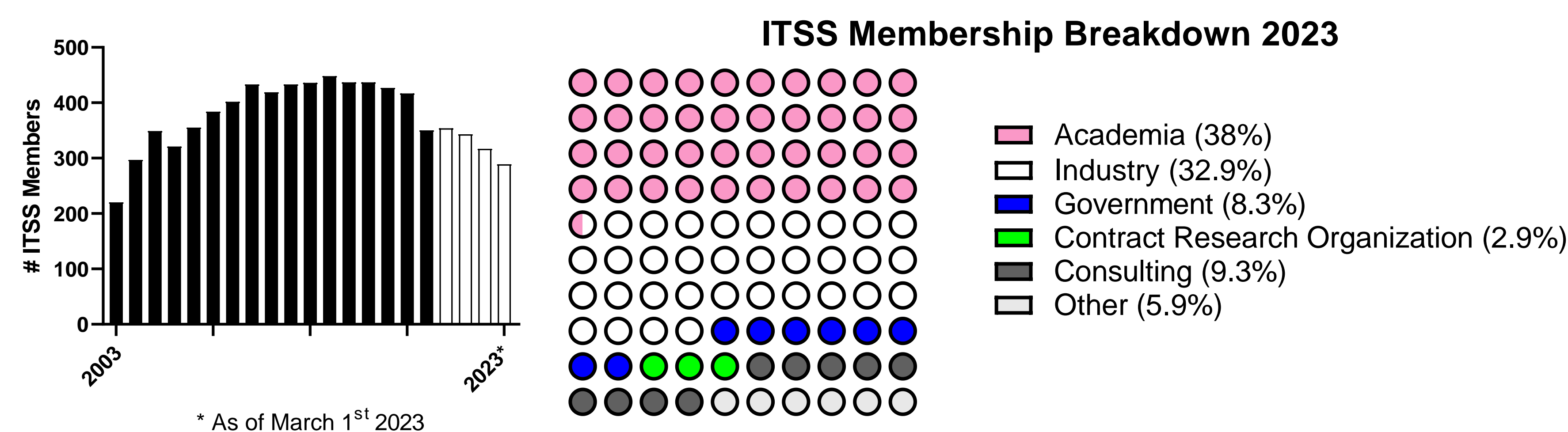

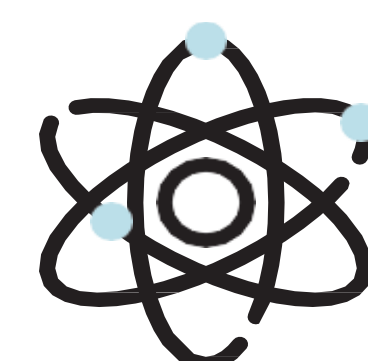
