II. Activities

2005-2006 Meetings:

The Fall, 2005 Mountain West SOT Chapter Conference was held in Santa Fe, New Mexico on September 15th and 16th, 2005. The thematic topic was Environmental Cardiology: The Role of Xenobiotics on Cardiovascular Health, with a keynote seminar from Dr. Kenneth Ramos of the University of Louisville. Other speakers included Todd Camenisch and Qin Chen from the University of Arizona, Mary Walker and Todd A Thompson from the University of New Mexico College of Pharmacy, and JeanClare Seagrave, Jacob McDonald, and Matthew Campen from Lovelace Respiratory Research Institute. Student presentations were given by Amie Lund, Wei Ding, and Phillip Kopf from the College of Pharmacy; Natalie Lassen and James Roede from the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, University of Colorado; Tiffany G. Bredfeldt from the Department of Pharmacology and Toxicology, College of Pharmacy, University of Arizona; Julie Buffington, College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences, Colorado State University; and Karen C. Thomas from the Department of Pharmacology and Toxicology, University of Utah. Overall attendance for the meeting was 70.

The Spring, 2006 Mountain West SOT meeting was held jointly with the Southern California Chapter at the 45th annual Society of Toxicology meeting in San Diego.
