 - Innovation in Toxicological Sciences
 - Innovation in Applied Toxicology
- Workshop (Generally accepted, state-of-the-art knowledge)
- Roundtable (Controversial subjects)

Submission Guideline

- All proposals must be submitted by April 30, 2008 at 11:59 EST to the SOT.
- All proposals must be submitted to AACT (to Jia-Sheng Wang “js.wang@ttu.edu”) by **April 15, 2008**.
- Each proposal is limited to 6000 characters.
- You will have the option to submit the proposal for more than one session type.
- All sessions except the Sunrise Mini-Course must have both a Chair and a Co-Chair who are members of SOT.

Getting Your SOT Program Proposal Accepted - Tips

- Get started early
- Assembly a good team of experts
- Develop your proposal through several drafts
- Solicit and utilize outside constructive criticism
- Appeal to 2-3 SIGs or specialty sections
