Highlights of AACT Bylaw Revisions

- Decrease Term of President, President-Elect and Past President from 2 years to 1 year (Councilors remain at 2 years for continuity) starting in 2013.
- For Consistency with other SOT Special Interest Groups
 - AACT members do not have to be members of SOT (restricted membership, i.e., can not be AACT Board Member, no discount on SOT Annual Meeting). This was just approved by SOT to increase SIG membership.
 - Immediate Past President, Post doc Rep, and Student Reps have voting rights (to keep odd [9] number of voting members, one councilor position will be eliminated)
 - Verbiage change for the nomination and election procedure due to SOT involvement in the process and term length change.
