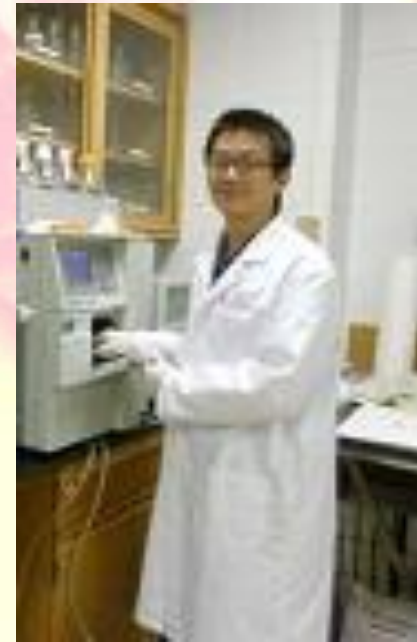

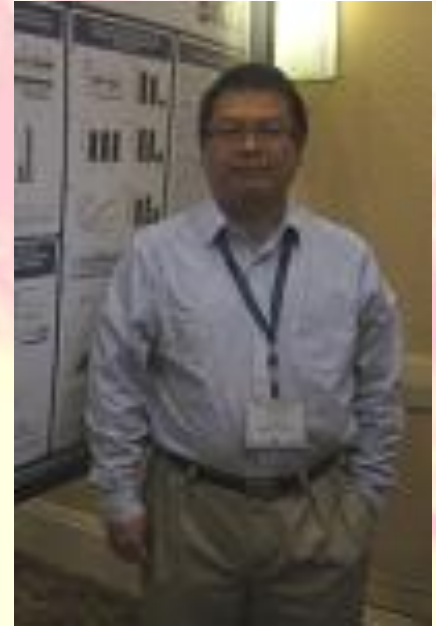

Background

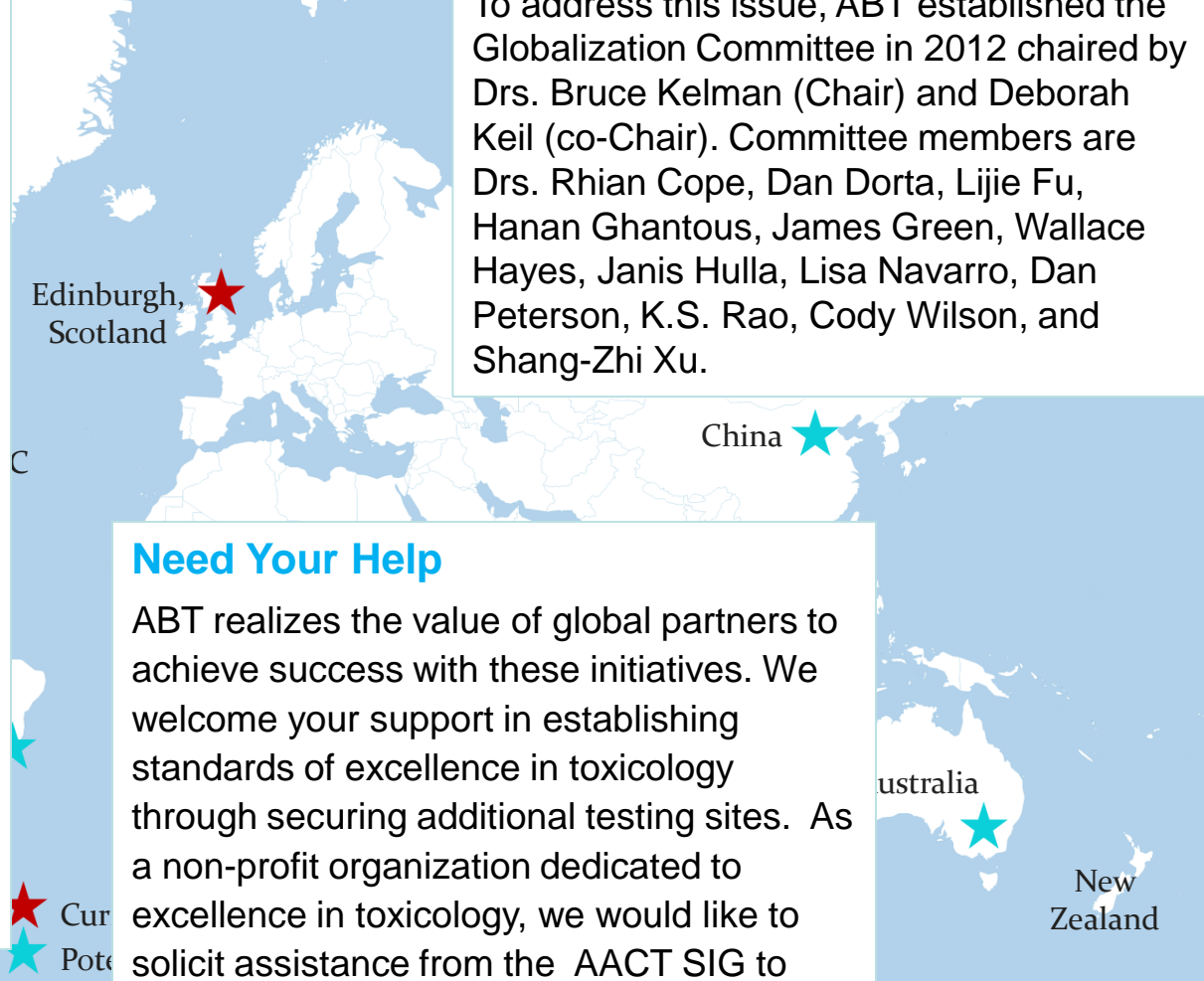
The Board of the American Board of Toxicology (ABT) believes that toxicologists are best served by identifying locations accessible to the greatest number of candidates eligible for the certifying examination. ABT is committed to broadening international access to the certifying examination and demonstrating high standards and a leadership role in the certification of toxicologists. Only six percent of ABT Diplomates reside outside the United States in countries or regions such as Canada, Europe, Australia, Japan, Korea, India, Singapore, and Taiwan. The Board has concluded that accessibility to ABT exam sites has, in part, impeded the certification process of toxicologists outside of North America.

Progress

To address this issue, ABT established the Globalization Committee in 2012 chaired by Drs. Bruce Kelman (Chair) and Deborah Keil (co-Chair). Committee members are Drs. Rhian Cope, Dan Dorta, Lijie Fu, Hanan Ghantous, James Green, Wallace Hayes, Janis Hulla, Lisa Navarro, Dan Peterson, K.S. Rao, Cody Wilson, and Shang-Zhi Xu.

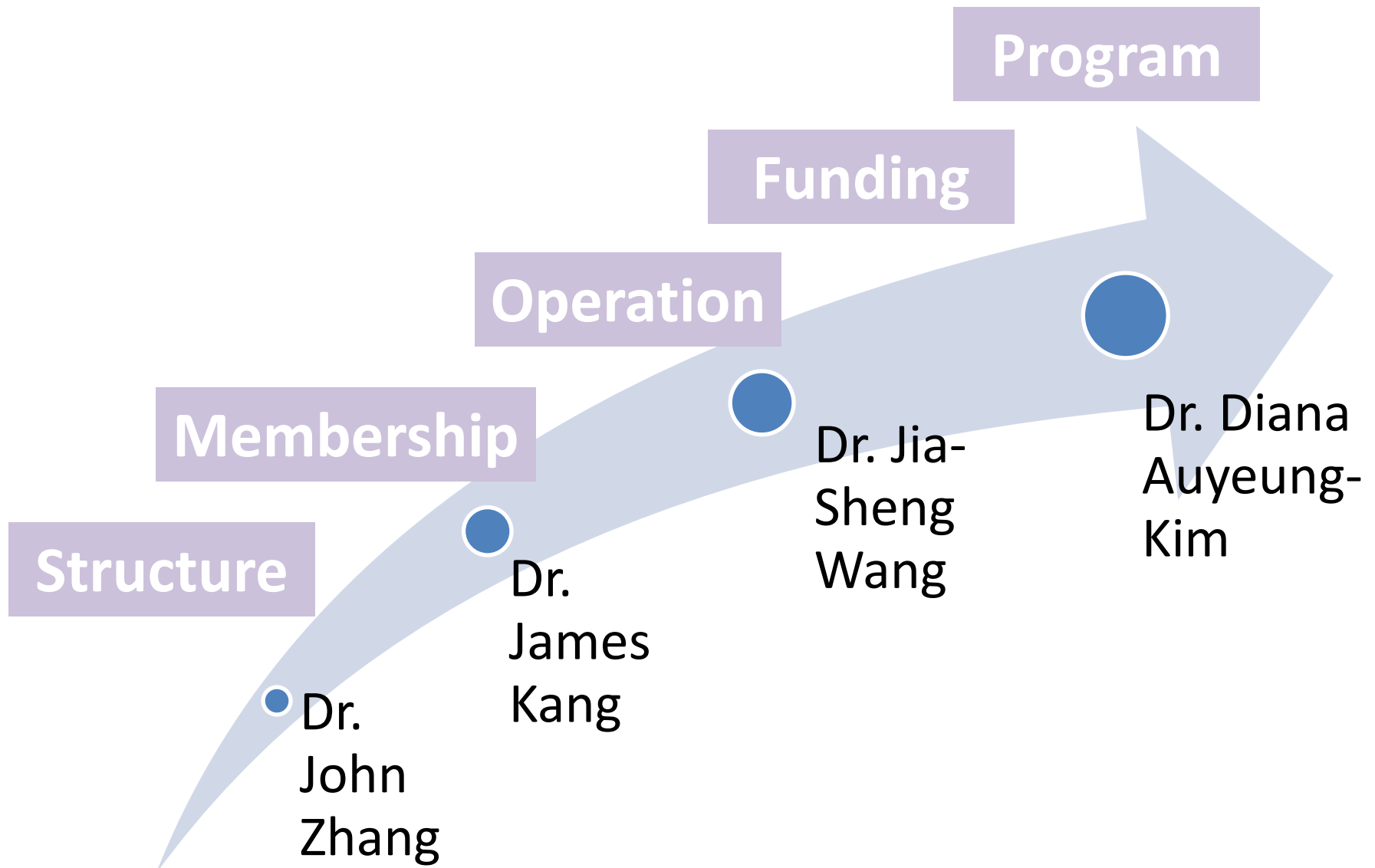

Building on a Great Foundation



Focusing on Next Step

- Set focus for next couple of years (**FIT**)
 - **F**orm a task force on international collaboration
 - Develop ideas that can enhance further interaction and collaboration with Chinese toxicologists outside of US
 - 2-year term; ≤ 8 people, need volunteers by mid April
 - **I**ncrease non-SOT members (people outside of US)
 - **T**ravel in a small delegation to attend CSOT in Nov
 - 2 travel awards, \$1,500 each
 - Award winners to be selected by task force
- Seek volunteers from broad range of institutions
 - Ideas, participation, other forms of support
