



ITSS Best Paper of the Year Award



This award is for the best paper in the area of immunotoxicology, published in ANY peer-reviewed journal between January 1 and December 31 of the current calendar year. The first publication date (either electronic or paper) will be considered the date of publication. Authors may not nominate their own papers. Review papers are not eligible for this award. For full consideration, first author and/or corresponding author will need to be ITSS members. An engraved plaque will be awarded to the authors.

Required Documents:

1. Full citation of the article (and/or pdf attachment)
2. Letter of support discussing the findings and value of the research

ITSS Best Presentation by a Postdoctoral Trainee Award

This award will be presented to the postdoctoral trainees whose work in the field of immunotoxicology is deserving of recognition.

Required Documents:

1. A copy of the original abstract submitted to the SOT Annual Meeting
2. Mentor's letter of support
3. Written version of a presentation (5-7 slides/7' + 3' Q&A) based on submitted abstract



ITSS Best Presentation by a Student Award



This award will be presented to the graduate student trainees whose work in the field of immunotoxicology is deserving of recognition.

Required Documents:

1. A copy of the original abstract submitted to the SOT Annual Meeting
2. Mentor's letter of support
3. Written version of a presentation (5-7 slides/7' + 3' Q&A) based on submitted abstract

ITSS Mitzi and Prakash Nagarkatti Research Excellence in Immunotoxicology Award

These awards are made possible by the Mitzi and Prakash Nagarkatti Research Excellence in Immunotoxicology Award Fund of the SOT Endowment Fund. This cash award will assist graduate students or postdoctoral scholars to attend the SOT Annual Meeting and present their research.

Required Documents:

1. Nomination letter from mentor
2. Up-to-date CV
3. Personal statement letter describing how the award will impact their career



ITSS HESI Immunotoxicology Young Investigator Travel Award

This award is made possible by the Health and Environmental Science Institute Immunotoxicology Young Investigator Student Award Fund of the SOT Endowment Fund. The nominees should be within five years of receiving a PhD. The cash award will assist young investigators to attend the SOT Annual Meeting and present their research. Both US and international investigators are eligible and encouraged to apply.

Requirements:

1. Letter from current advisor indicating contributions to immunotoxicology field
2. Up-to-date CV
3. Personal statement letter regarding attendance at SOT and career development in immunotoxicology

ITSS Outstanding Senior Immunotoxicologist Award

The Outstanding Senior Immunotoxicologist Award is for scientists in academia, industry, or regulatory entities whose work has made significant contributions to the field of immunotoxicology. The nominees must have at least 10 years of experience since obtaining their highest degree. Nominees must have distinguished themselves as leaders in their chosen area of immunotoxicology and not previously been awarded the Vos Lifetime Career Achievement Award. Self-nominations will not be considered.

Required Documents:

1. Nomination letter
2. Summary of awardee's accomplishments in immunotoxicology
3. Up-to-date CV and Bibliography

ITSS Outstanding Young Immunotoxicologist Award

This award will be presented to postdoctoral trainees and junior independent scientists in academia, industry, or regulatory entities. The nominees must have up to 10 years of experience since obtaining their highest degree. Exceptions to the 10-year limitation can be made if careers have been interrupted for family or health reasons, or clinical practice, etc. Reasons for the exception should be documented in the nomination letter. Self-nominations will not be considered.

Required Documents:

1. Nomination letter
2. Nominee's up-to-date CV and Bibliography



ITSS Vos Lifetime Career Achievement Award in Immunotoxicology

This award will be presented to a Senior Investigator (at least 20 years since obtaining their highest degree) whose body of work represents an outstanding career in immunotoxicology. Nominees are evaluated with respect to the following criteria: 1) Contribution to immunotoxicology field, 2) Influence in education/training/mentorship of young scientists in immunotoxicology, 3) Leadership/service to immunotoxicology, and 4) Influence on regulatory and risk/safety assessment decisions in immunotoxicology.

Required Documents:

1. Letter discussing the impact of the nominee's work to advance the immunotoxicology field
2. Nominee's up-to-date CV and Bibliography
3. Supporting letter of recommendation from another investigator

Postdoctoral Report:


Greetings ITSS Postdocs:
