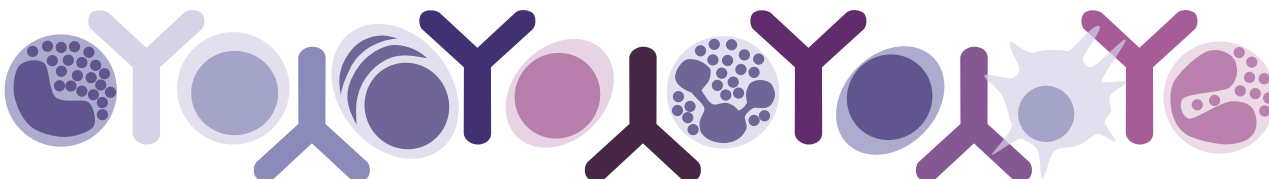
ITSS Mentoring & Networking Event

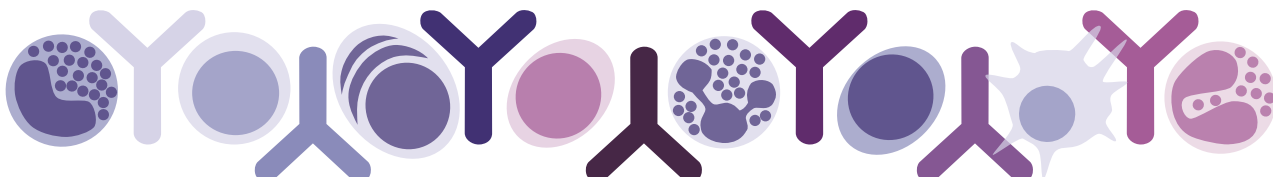
